LIMITATIONS ON THE USE OF A SPECIAL HAULING PERMIT

1. The granting of a permit does not guarantee that the load described can be moved without damage to the pavement or structures; although the permit is granted on the assumption that the load can be moved without damage based on the best information available.
2. Permittee will be held liable for any damage caused by the movement. The County assumes no responsibility for damage to the permittee's equipment or load being moved due to any such failure. The permittee agrees to compensate the County for any damage to a roadway or road structure and also to indemnify, save harmless, and defend Morrow County from and against all and any liabilities, losses, obligations, claims, damages, penalties, suits, actions, judgements, costs and expenses of whatsoever nature are incurred or brought against Morrow County as the result of injury to or death of persons or damages to or loss of property caused by acts or omission to act by the Permittee, its agents, servants and employees in the performance of movements under this permit.
3. The permit shall be in the possession of the driver at all times during the progress of transportation and will be shown on demand to any police officer, state highway patrolman, or load limit inspector.
4. The permission granted restricts the movement of the vehicle(s) or object(s) to the highways specified, between the point designated, and within the time allotted.
5. No vehicle(s) or object(s) in excess of the legal limits prescribed by law shall be permitted on the highway on Saturdays, Sundays or during the period beginning at 12 noon on the day preceding and continuing until sunrise on the day following national holidays or holiday weekends.
6. Movements under a special hauling permit shall be made during daylight hours only and in such a manner to impede the least possible extent the normal highway traffic.
7. No vehicle(s) or object(s) being transported under special hauling permit shall be left parked on the roadway either day or night except in case of an emergency, in which case adequate protection shall be provided for the traveling public. The vehicle(s) shall not be loaded or unloaded within the limits of the highway.
8. The operator of the vehicle must comply with all laws, rules, or regulations covering the movement of traffic over highways and streets.
9. No vehicle(s) or object(s) being transported under a special hauling permit shall travel in convoy with any other oversize/overweight vehicle or vehicle and load. Every vehicle operating under a permit shall maintain a minimum spacing of 500' from all vehicles traveling in front of and in the same lane as said vehicle whenever possible.
10. Every vehicle operating under a permit shall, when traveling on freeways, expressways, or multi-lane undivided highways, remain in the extreme right-hand lane of said highway except as necessary to maintain continuous through movement, to make left turns or exits or to pass other vehicles. Overwidth vehicles shall not pass other vehicles traveling in the same direction.
11. All flags, signs, escort vehicles, safety lighting devices, flagpersons, etc., as required in the below listed Special Provisions must meet the specifications as provided in Section 5501:2-1-01 through 5501:2-1-12, Ohio Administrative Code, and Transportation Directive 24-A dated May 15, 1983.
12. Permits will not generally be issued for built-up loads that are divisible into legal loads, or into loads of the least over dimension or the least over weight. If, in the event of an extenuating circumstance, a permit is issued for a divisible load, such load will be adequately described.
13. A permit is void at any time road, weather or traffic conditions make travel unsafe.
14. Reductions in legal weight posted on roadways or bridges must be obeyed.
15. Non-compliance with the general or special provisions of a permit, exceeding the weights or dimensions granted, or operating on dates or upon highways other than assigned shall render the permit null and void and the operator of the vehicle subject to arrest, as provided in sections 5577.02 to 5577.05 inclusive of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. Display clean red flags not less than 16" square and fastened to staffs of sufficient length so as to permit the flags to move freely of any obstructions, located as follows: One at each end of the front bumper at the 45° angle, one at each of the four corners of the vehicle or load, and if there is any part of the load wider, one at the widest point on either side.
2. Private escort vehicle to proceed 500' in advance of vehicle/load.
3. Private escort vehicle to follow 500' back of vehicle/load.
4. Police escort required to assist traffic control.
5. Oversize load signs must be attached to front and rear of vehicle/load.
6. Lead escort vehicle must be equipped with a height sensing device.
7. All provisions as listed on Form \_\_\_\_\_ apply to this move. Form \_\_\_\_\_ must be attached to this permit.
8. Movement is restricted to Tuesday-Wednesday-Thursday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
9. Movement is to be made between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
10. Driver of the escort vehicle is to act as flagman when needed.
11. Note limitation #5 regarding holiday travel restrictions.
12. Move must be coordinated with the owners of all overhead signs, signals, utilities, etc., which may obstruct safe, clear movement.
13. Special provision #2 applies to bidirectional, two lane highways. Special provision #3 applies to multiple lane highways.
14. All movements shall be made at such speeds and in such manner as to cause a minimum of interference with other traffic and minimum impact stresses on structures and pavements. No movement is to exceed forty (40) miles per hour at any time, except upon that portion of a highway where the posted minimum speed is in excess of thirty-five (35) miles per hour. In this event, the maximum allowable speed is then five (5) miles per hour greater than the posted minimum speed for that highway.

Preliminary Information requested from you.

1. Exact route, final route plan, time schedule, and alternate plan if \_\_\_\_\_ cannot be moved in one move between 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M.
2. Move shall be coordinated with the owners of all overhead signs, signals, utilities, etc. which may obstruct safe clear movement. Also included shall be the contacting of school systems and fire control. Written verification from the same that they have been contacted.
3. Mover shall provide adequate safety forces for traffic control.
4. Permission to travel or cross State Roads and Township Roads must be obtained from proper authorities.
5. Actual permit if issued shall have detailed limitations specified further.
6. Detailed diagram to show estimated axle loads, heights and widths. (Exact dimensions.)
7. Liability Insurance - \$2 Million BI/PD, \$1 Million Auto and \$4 Million umbrella coverage.
8. Final approval of permit attached, if granted, shall be granted by the Morrow County Commissioners and the Morrow County Engineer. A \$50.00 fee will be charged for this permit.
